

1. Complete the enclosed Vote By Mail Application form.
2. Sign it and mail it back in the enclosed envelope. Your application should be mailed early so that it arrives by the February 19, 2015 deadline.
3. When you receive your ballot in the mail from the Chicago Board of Elections, cast your vote and send it back immediately. A completed ballot must be postmarked on or before Monday, February 23, 2015.

Voting by mail is a dependable way to vote and allows you to vote on your schedule in the convenience of your own home. Your friends and family are relying on you to vote.
